Invitation for Negotiated Procurement

- 1. In view of two (2) failed biddings, the Cotabato State University, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invites interested bidders to participate in the negotiation for the Supply and Delivery of Motor Vehicles with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P1,960,000.00) in accordance with Section 53.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA)".
- 2. The Cotabato State University, through the Trust Fund FY2021 intends to apply the sum of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱1,800,000.00) for Supply and Delivery of One (1) Unit Utility/Passenger Van; and One Hundred Sixty Thousand Pesos (₱160,000.00) for Supply and Delivery of Two (2) Units Motorcycle being the ABC to payments under the contract for each lot. Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 3. The *Cotabato State University* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required within 45 days from receipt of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed, within *three* (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

- 4. The CSU-BAC, will hold a Negotiation Conference on November 13, 2021(Sat) @10:00am, via online platform which shall be opened only to those bidders who have submitted their respective Letter-of-Intent to Participate will be allowed in the Negotiation Conference. Interested bidders may send One (1) technical and/or administrative representatives who will prepare their Proposal.
- 5. All Proposals shall contain the Eligibility and Technical Documents, as well as the Financial Documents prescribed in the Bidding Documents.
- Proposals must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before November 15, 2021 (Mon) at 2:00PM All Proposals must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18. Late bids shall not be accepted.

- 7. Bid opening and evaluation shall be on *November 15, 2021 (Monday) @ 2:00PM* at the Conference Room, Research Building, Cotabato State University, Cotabato City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

The *Cotabato State University* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
