INVITATION TO BID FOR *PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY* SERVICES

- The COTABATO CITY STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE, through the Agency Income (PRE) FY 2016⁻¹ intends to apply the sum of ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND PESOS (₱1,272,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Procurement of Security Services. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The Cotabato City State Polytechnic College now invites bids for the Procurement of Security Services² Delivery of the Goods is required effective August16, 2016 to August 15, 2017. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
- Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

- 4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *COTABATO CITY STATE POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours at 8:00am 5:00pm.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders on *July 18*, 2016 from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of P1,200.00.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
